Case reports are the weakest form of scientific evidence. However, the brilliant cures achieved by homeopathic doctors are not recognized as scientific evidence because they are not published in a peer-reviewed, indexed journal. In this scenario, the Yenepoya Homeopathic Medical College has geared up to provide the necessary training for homeopathic doctors to publish their case reports. We will provide hands-on experience in writing a case report using the software '**CARE writer**'. We will provide participants with case material and guide them in converting it into a case report. Additionally, we will introduce participants to **Grammarly** and **Zotero**. We will also teach participants to identify peer-reviewed, indexed journals and select the appropriate journal for their manuscript.
