

Submission Guidelines

- » **Word limit:** 250–300 words.
- » **Title:** Bold, sentence case (not all caps).
- » **Author details:** Full name, institution name, city, whatsapp number and email of presenting author.
- » **Original Research:** Abstract must be structured under the following headings: Background/Introduction, Aims & Objectives, Methodology, Results, Conclusion, Keywords (3–5).
- » **Case report/ Case Series:** Background/Introduction – Why the case is significant, Discussion – Response to treatment, Learning points, Conclusion – Key message, Keywords (3–5)

Submission Process

- » **Open Forum Presentations are included at No Extra Cost.**
- » Registration is mandatory prior to abstract submission.
- » Submit your abstract via hmcfmt@fathermuller.in
- » Deadline for submission: **01-02-2026**

Review & Selection

- » All abstracts will undergo peer review by the Selection Committee.
- » Selection will be based on originality, relevance, scientific quality and clarity.
- » Model template shall be sent to your mail after selection and all matters shall be presented on that template only.
- » **Acceptance will be notified through the registered Email ID.**
