NOTIFICATION

Subject: Inviting applications for Master of Public Health (Health System Management, Epidemiology & Global Health)– 2 year full-time programme at School of Public Health, Thiruvananthapuram.

1.It is hereby notified that the Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS) is inviting applications from eligible Candidates for pursuing two year full-time Postgraduate degree program in Master of Public Health (Health System Management, Epidemiology & Global Health) through School of Public Health, Thiruvananthapuram for the academic year 2026-27.

2. Eligibility:

- Candidates who have completed undergraduate degree courses in health science subjects belonging to Medical / Dental / Ayurveda / Unani / Siddha / Homeopathy / Nursing / Pharmacy / Allied Health streams from KUHS or courses deemed as equivalent by the KUHS and who have registered under the respective councils(as applicable) of the state are eligible to pursue the programme.
- Graduates in Veterinary Sciences, Fisheries, Agricultural Sciences, and registered under respective councils(as applicable) are also eligible to pursue the programme.
- In-service candidates from DME, DHS and ESI are eligible to apply for the course. They should submit a Non-Objection Certificate from the concerned authority at the time of admission.
- No degrees earned through a correspondence course will be considered as eligibility for seeking admission to the course.
- The maximum age limit of the candidate shall not be more than fifty years as on 31st December of the admission year. A candidate seeking admission under KUHS must be an Indian National. Candidates having Overseas Citizen of India card or Nationality other than India shall be admitted under KUHS, only if permitted by the government.
- A candidate seeking admission under KUHS must be certified as Medically fit to undergo the programme by an official competent for the same.
- There shall be no provision of stipend for the Programme.





3. Application Fee

Application fee, including entrance examination fee, is Rs.2500/- for General category and Rs.2000/- for SC/ST categories. The application fee is non-refundable under any circumstances.

4. How to apply

Applications are to be submitted online till 17.08.2026. Visit the University website **www.kuhs.ac.in** and access the Registration Link provided in the **Announcements**.

- Registration requires the following details: Name, Mobile Number, and Email ID.
- Upon successful registration, the Username and Password will be sent to the registered Email ID.
- After registering in the website, the candidate should login using the login name and password and should submit the online application.

The submission of online application includes the following steps:

Step 1:

- a. Submit personal information
- b. Submit qualification details
- c. Upload Photo and Signature
- d. Upload self attested copies of all the relevant certificates such as SSLC (proof of age), Plus Two, degree/provisional degree certificate, Degree Mark list (consolidated), Transfer Certificate from Institution, community certificate (OBC/SC/ST/EWS/PwD), non-creamy layer, Council Registration certificate(If applicable).

8. Mode of Admission





- The Selection of candidates/in-service candidates for the course is based on the entrance examination conducted by the university
- The question papers for Entrance Examination will consist of objective type multiple choice questions. The answer sheet will be of the OMR type.
- The Entrance Examination will comprise of multiple-choice questions that assess the subject knowledge with total marks of 100.
- The questions will be focussing on

- The category wise rank list will be published based on the entrance examination. Selected candidates will be issued admission memo.

9. Fee structure

- The Tuition fee is Rs. 50,000/- (Fifty Thousand Rupees) per candidate per semester. The Tuition fees should be paid at the beginning of each semester.
- In addition, students shall remit a one-time fee of Rs. 3885/- (Three Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-Five Only) towards Admission fee (including Student Registration fee, Certificate Verification, Identity card, University Union fee and Sports fee) and Rs. 30,000/- towards Caution Deposit along with the fee for First semester.
- The examination fee should be fixed by the University from time to time and should be remitted by the students separately.

10. Execution of Bond

A bond in the prescribed format for an amount of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Only) shall be executed by the student at the time of registration to the Programme.



11. General Conditions

1. Candidates must follow the instructions strictly as given in the notification and course prospectus.
2. Application Forms not complying with the instructions are liable to be rejected.
3. Only Indian nationals are eligible to apply for these programmes. Applicants whose place of birth and/or prior education is from a foreign country must submit supporting evidence, such as Indian passport. If, at any point during or after admission, it is found that the candidate is not a citizen of India, their admission will be forfeited, and they shall be subjected to legal action as per law.
4. Only candidates who are natives of Kerala are eligible for communal reservation. Non-Keralites will be treated as General Category candidates. The applicants must produce a valid nativity certificate from the competent authority of Kerala to prove that they are natives of Kerala, at the time of admission.
5. Those candidates who had completed their qualifying examination from other Universities shall produce an equivalency certificate from the concerned University. If they fail to submit the same before the stipulated time, they will not be considered for admission.
6. The candidate should produce all the original documents required by the University at the time of admission for verification purpose, failing which, their candidature for admission will be forfeited and admission shall be cancelled at any stage.
7. Candidates eligible for reservation should submit their application in the relevant category. If a candidate has applied under the General Category, he/she will be treated as General, even if, he/she is eligible to apply under the reservation category.
8. No individual intimation will be sent to the candidates. Candidates shall update themselves with the University Website (www.kuhs.ac.in) and with the University Press releases for the latest information.
9. For updates, candidates are directed to refer to the Prospectus and updates published in the University website.
